1. Registration for this event closes on 5th November 2025
2. Registrations will only be accepted on submission of this form. We cannot accept registrations over the phone.
3. Completion of this form confirms your interest in attending the event. It does not guarantee your attendance. We will confirm spaces at this event no later than Friday 7th November 2025.
4. Meningitis Now will give attendees maximum practical notice of any unforeseen cancellation or change to the event.
5. If fewer than five people sign up for a session, then the event will not go ahead. If there is a low uptake on the events for under 18's, we may look to merge into one group for 11-17's. We will communicate this to Young People and Parents prior to the event and seek consent where needed.
6. We are capping each session at twelve people, with 2 additional spaces available for Peer Mentors. If more than twelve people sign up, we will run a waiting list and contact those on a first come first served basis.
7. We ask that under 18s have a parent/guardian present in the house during the event who will be available as an emergency contact.
8. All participants must have read and agreed to the E-Safety Agreement by ticking the relevant box at the point of registering for the online event. A parent/guardian must also tick the box if the participant is under 18.
9. We will use Zoom as the delivery platform for this event. If you sign up, you consent to you, or your Young Person, using this platform to join.
10. Meningitis Now is not government funded, and our online events are generously funded by The National Lottery Community Fund and other donors. If people book,

but don't attend, it means others miss out. It also means Meningitis Now wastes precious funds. If you need to cancel, please give as much notice as possible.
